- Advocating for a fundamental right to marriage encompassing same-sex couples in *Obergefell v. Hodges* ;
- Arguing that the rescission of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals was arbitrary and capricious and thus unlawful in *Department of Homeland Security v. Regents of the University of California* ; and
- Arguing the unconstitutionality of overly vague federal criminal laws in *McDonnell v. United States* .
